- **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Betts called the meeting to order and determined a quorum. Present were Kevin Painter, Andrew Rhodes, and Angi Mathenia. Marc Murdaugh was not present.

- **APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Alderman Rhodes made a motion to approve agenda of June 8th as written. Alderman Mathenia seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

- **BULK PICKUP CONTRACT RENEWAL**

City recorder reviewed the current Waste Management contract renewal date will be June 2028 and confirmed with RAKK Solid that their upcoming contract renewal will come extend to June 2028. Therefore, the city would have the availability to put both contracts out for bid at same time in 2028. RAKK Solid cost will remain the same as is for the remaining two years. After review of the cost for bulk paid for this current year with existing Solid Waste Fund, the board discussed increasing garbage pickup fees either \$6 or \$8 per household to cover bulk fees from this point forward. After much discussion, Alderman Rhodes made the motion to approve additional \$6 fee to be added to garbage fees to total \$28 per month per household. Alderman Mathenia seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

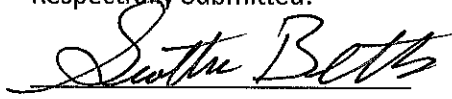
- **SAFER GRANT APPLICATION**

Fire Chief Cleveland reviewed the Safer Grant Application that is due by end of June for submission. His request is for 3 full-time firemen to be included in this grant. He noted that the part-time cost that was approved in budget would decrease this cost in the graduated schedule to reduce the cost per year as noted in the 4 year breakdown. After much discussion, Alderman Mathenia made a motion to approve submitting for 2 persons in the grant submission. Andrew Rhodes seconded the motion. Motion passed 3-1 with Alderman Painter noting his support of this submission but voting no in that he would be in favor of 1 person at this time.
