- **CALL TO ORDER**

- A. Mayor Betts called the meeting to order and determined a quorum. Present were Kevin Painter, Andrew Rhodes, and Marc Murdaugh. Angi Mathenia was absent.

- **OPENING CEREMONIES**

- **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM REGULAR SCHEDULED MEETING September 8, 2025**

- Motion was made by Alderman Murdaugh to approve minutes of regular meeting on September 8, 2025. Alderman Painter seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

- **APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM SPECIAL CALLED MEETING September 23, 2025**

- Motion was made by Alderman Painter to approve minutes from special called meeting on September 23, 2025. Alderman Rhodes seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

- **APPROVAL OF AGENDA FOR October 2, 2025**

- Motion was made by Alderman Murdaugh to approve agenda for October 2, 2025. Alderman Painter seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

- **REPORTS**

- A. Parks and Recreation / Public Works-

- Mike Hutcherson reported that public works was completing regular street maintenance along with installation of various signage. Asphalt paving Vista Drive is projected to start on Friday as per contractor. New playground is open along with pickleball court. Court will have to close temporarily for repairs. As of last Friday, all police officers are now CPR certified.

- B. Fire Chief-

- Mark Cleveland reported 24 calls for month of September, none being fire calls. There were 14 county calls being 10 medical assists, 2 fire, 1 motor vehicle and 1 assist.

- C. Building Inspector –

Matt Brown reported 1 building permit and 1 plumbing permit issued for September. There is Liberty Tobacco & Beer Store opening in new strip mall next to old skating rink building. He noted there was no word on the new service station opening at this time. He noted the Chamber is coming to talk with the owner relating to some interested franchises for the end caps. He noted that Casey is meeting with TDOT tomorrow in reference to turn lane requirements. Circle K has pulled permit application but has not turned completed forms.

D. Police Chief-

Phillip Kemper reported 5 arrests, 283 calls for service, 39 citations, and 2045 camera citations issued for month of September. He noted there is one open police officer position, but a new hire will be starting next week October 14th. Flock cameras are running on a 90-day trial to determine where the best locations are to place the 4 for the city. E-tickets are scheduled to be in operation in the month of October. He noted that the new and used vehicle has been purchased. One is waiting for radio installation.


Alderman Painter made the motion to approve first reading as written. Alderman Rhodes seconded the motion. Motion passed 4-0.

- **BOARD MEMBERS AND MAYOR REPORTS AND CONCERNS**


Kevin Painter	Thanked Fire Chief and Firemen for school presentation and appreciated the flexibility to reset board meeting.
