- **CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Betts called the meeting to order and determined a quorum. Present were Kevin Painter, Andrew Rhodes, Marc Murdaugh, and Angi Mathenia.

- **BID ACCEPTANCE FOR CIVIC CENTER ROOF REPLACEMENT**

Bid amounts were submitted, it was noted that the funds would have to come from reserves of General Fund. J.M. Roofing was low bidder with the amount being \$50,610.00. After discussion, Alderman Painter made motion to acceptance bid from J.M. Roofing in the amount of \$50,610.00. Alderman Rhodes seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

- **UPDATED PERSONNEL POLICY REVIEW**

Personnel Policy updates were reviewed. It was agreed that the following changes be made- page 15 add "or more" back in, page 36 deletion of paragraph 2 under (5.) Random Testing noting "last three categories", page 50 addition of "employer" shall be per Tennessee state employer standard rate.

- **2026-2027 BUDGET DISCUSSION**


City recorder reviewed the Solid Waste, Drug Fund, and Street Aid upcoming budgets asking for consideration of additional funds going asphalt paving if possible. It was discussed as to when to increase garbage rates to cover cost of bulk pickup.

General Fund budget was reviewed. Fire Chief presented request for \$175,200 for part time employees 24/7 to include additional \$15,000 for payroll taxes. There was much discussion of current budget financial restrictions and Mayor discussed option of raising city sticker fees and consideration of raising property taxes. Further discussion will continue at next budget meeting. Meeting adjourned.
